







1. Log in

- a. Log in to your institution's Learning Management System (Blackboard, Canvas, Moodle, D2L).
- b. Navigate into your course.
- c. Select the "ProctorFree Exams" or "ProctorFree Student Portal" link.

2. Launch ProctorFree

- a. The link will launch the ProctorFree Student Portal.
 - i. If your institution uses Student Pay, you will be prompted to complete payment after selecting your exam.
- b. Select your exam from the available list.
- c. ProctorFree will launch and begin the System Check.

3. Create your Profile or Authenticate

- a. Think of this as taking a series of pictures for your driver's license or passport.
 - Tips are provided at the end of this guide and image examples are available on the ProctorFree Support Knowledge Base.
- b. When you are ready, click the "Create Profile" or "Authenticate" button to begin the process. Remain still. You will see the progress percentage increasing as the system creates your profile or completes authentication.

4. Completing your exam

- a. Click the "Start Proctored Session" button.
- b. Read the honor code and type your name exactly as it appears in the first line. Press the "Confirm" button.
- c. After your ProctorFree webcam recording window has loaded, your exam will open in a new tab.
- d. Take the exam following the instructions provided by your instructor.
- e. When you have completed your work, submit your exam.
- f. Once your exam has been submitted, click the "Finish" button under the ProctorFree webcam recording window. Select "Finish" again when prompted. The webcam screen will indicate it is finishing the upload of your exam session to ProctorFree. Allow the process to finish fully before closing your browser, powering down your computer, or disconnecting from the internet.

Tips for Profiling or Authenticating

- Position yourself so that your face is centered and filling the oval provided.
- Adjust lighting to ensure your face is clearly visible. The oval outline will be green to indicate the minimum lighting requirements are met.
- Remove glasses, headphones, hats, and adjust any other objects that may prevent a clear view of your entire face from ear to ear, as well as from the top of your forehead to the bottom of your chin.
- Remain still until the process is complete.

<u>About what</u>, we may range from hardware components to software packages, from physical systems to the users of the physical systems, from team members to team managers, etc.

About to what, it is essential to clear specify the Standard, and/or Guidelines, and/or Best Practices the exam questions are targeted

About for whom, the questions to be addressed are about "which certification is right for me?" or "why I want to get this certification?"

TQC Examination Board

The TQC Examination Board handles the TQC Examination process of the Applicant



- ➤ The Examination Board is composed of TIEMS representatives belonging to TIEMS International Group of Experts (TIGE)
- ➤ The Examination Board reflects the spectrum of emergency management expertise knowledgeable of existing Standards and Best Practices
- ➤ The Examination Board ensures that successful Applicants have met the minimum standards outlined in the Certification Program, both in terms of Essay Questions and Multiple Choice Questions
- TQC examination does not cover specific national standards and procedure, because it is assumed that the Applicant is already certified at national level, or competence approved at national level if a national certification does not exist

According to ISO 31000 Guidelines for Risk Management, Section 6.4.3 Risk analysis,

The purpose of risk analysis is to comprehend the nature of risk and its characteristics including, where appropriate, the level of risk. Risk analysis should consider factors such as:

- 1. The organization's culture;
- 2. The likelihood of events and consequences;
- 3. Authorities, responsibilities and accountabilities;
- 4. The way in which conflicting objectives are dealt with.

According to **ISO 22320 Guidelines for Incident Management, Section 6.2.2 Seeing the whole picture,** The organization should look beyond its scope of operations to consider and understand factors such as:


- 1. The resources available for its activities;
- 2. The other organizations involved and their capabilities;
- 3. The tasks allocated to other organizations;
- 4. The possible effects of its own activities.


