

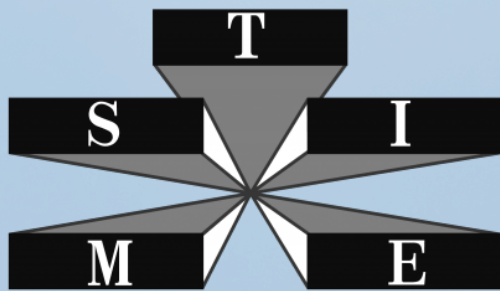

- **Key engagement for new TIEMS members and audiences**



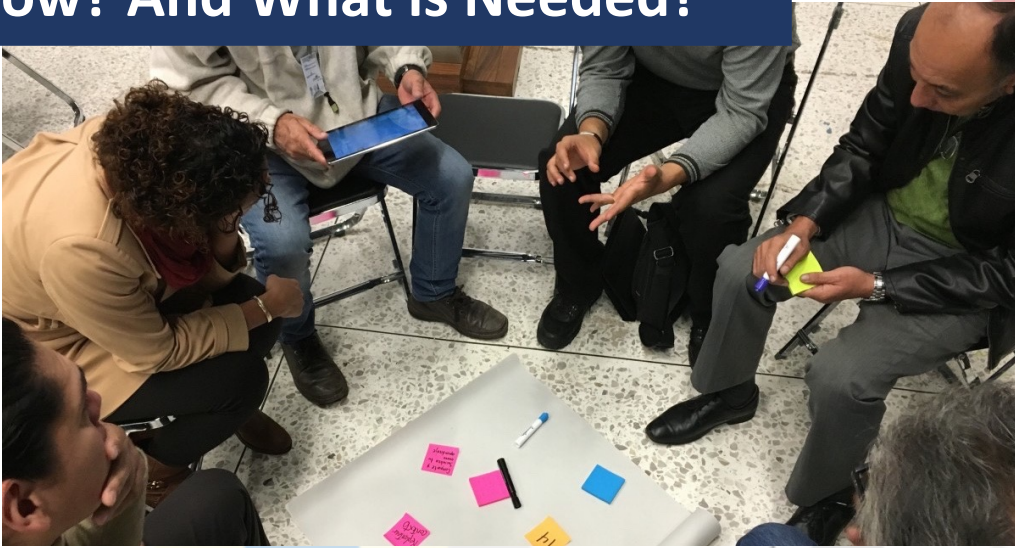


# What can we do in 2022?
