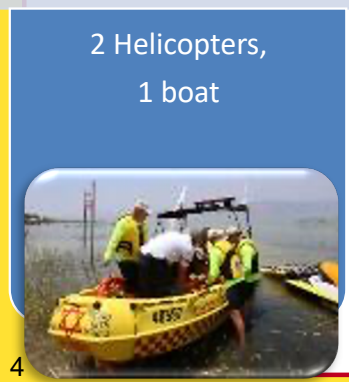

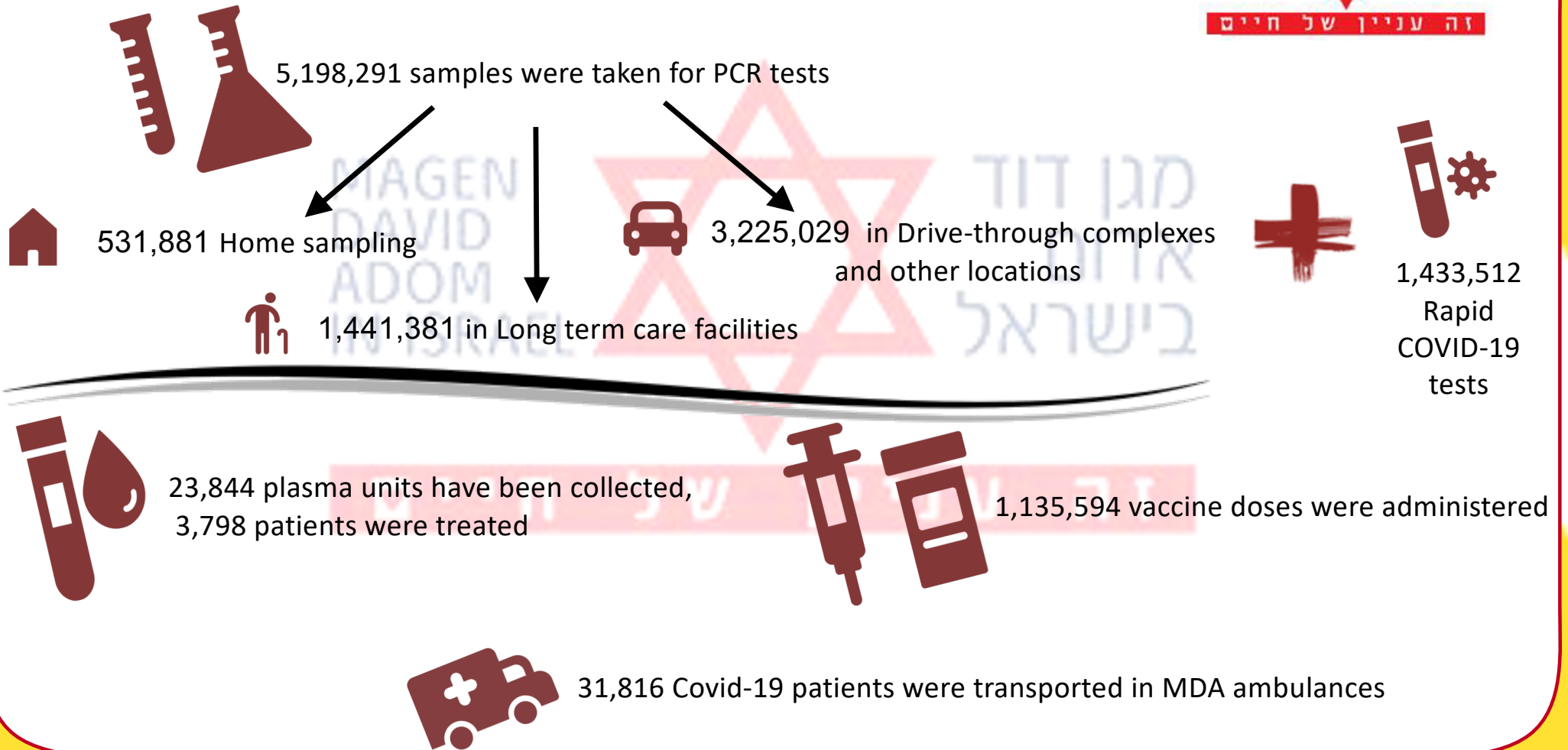


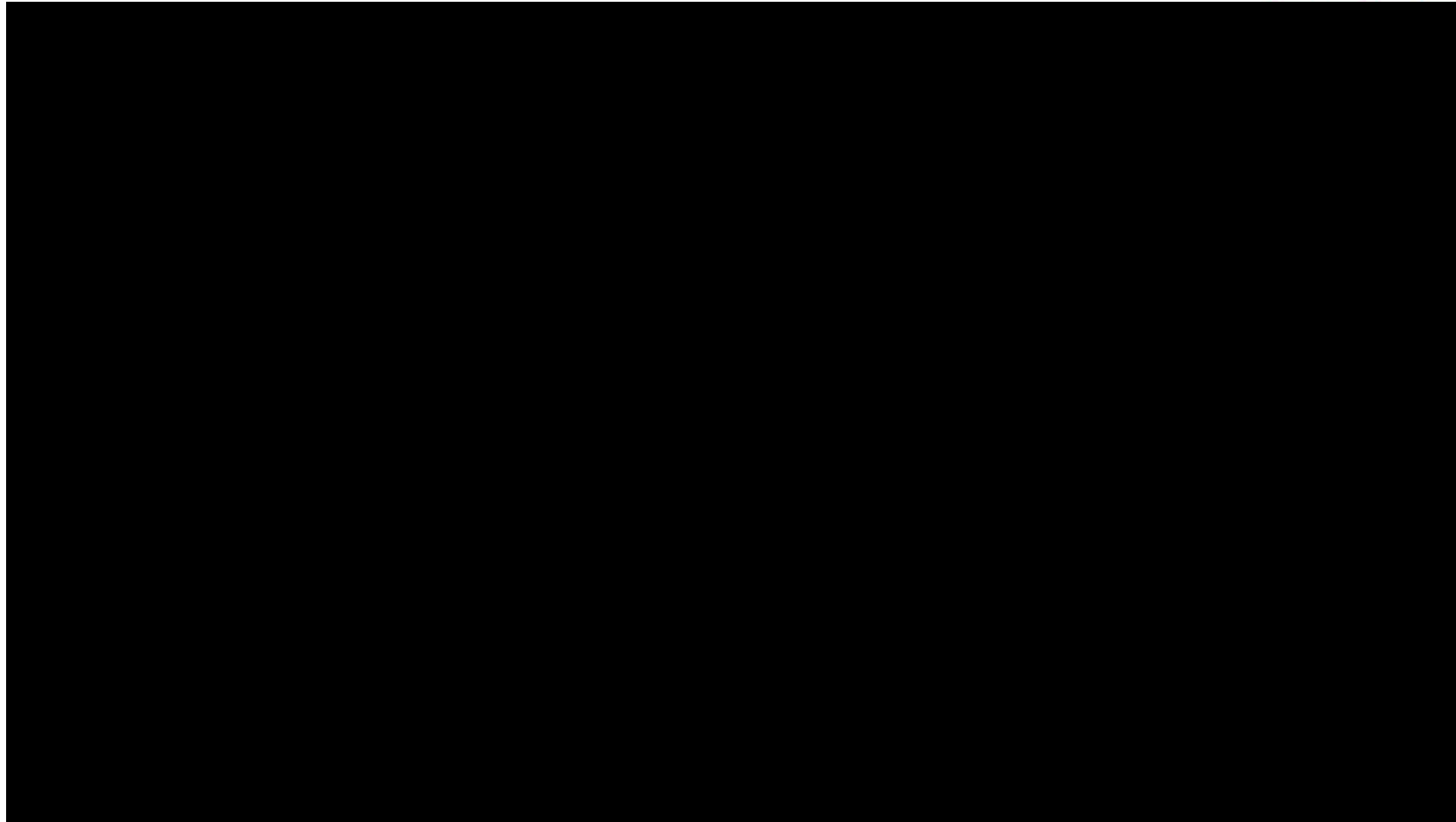

- **pinpoint areas for future research**

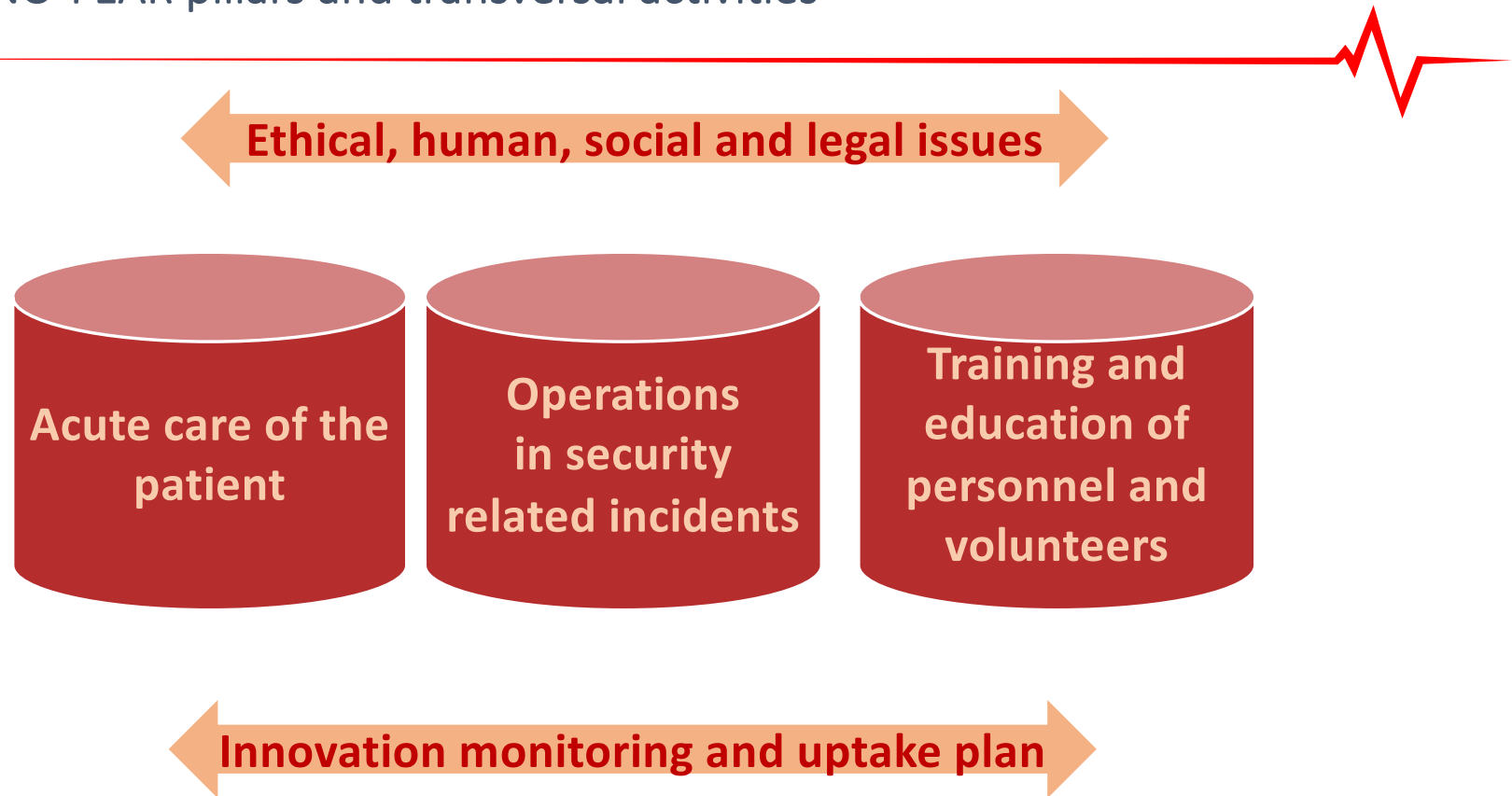

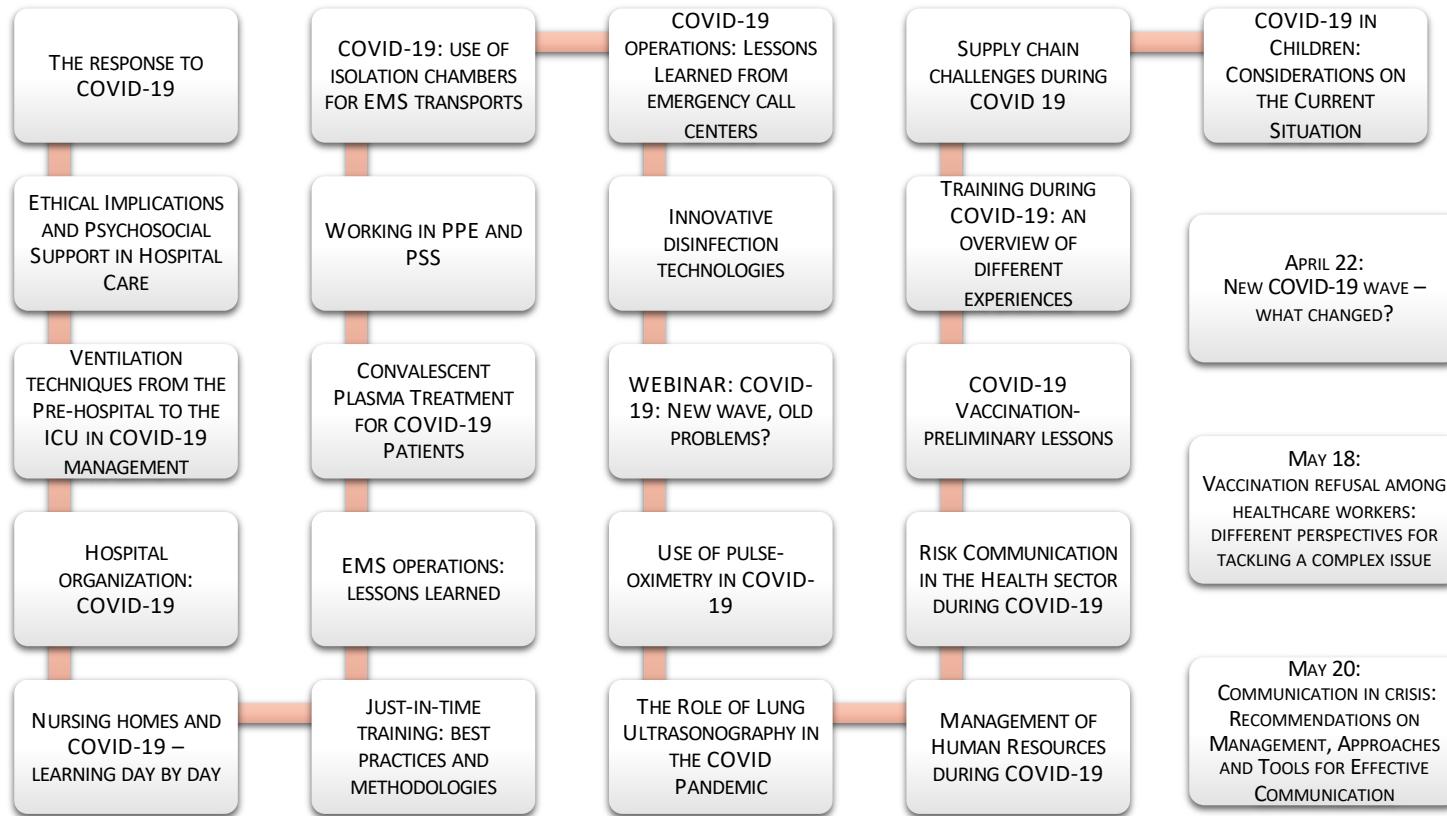
